**By the end of this course, students will be able to:**

- 1) Be able to identify four areas of current theological debate, place them in an historical context and identify appropriate ways of addressing the issues.
- 2) Be able to identify four major Christian theologians, place them in an historical context and identify the contributions they have made to an understanding of the church's faith.
- 3) Be able to identify the major theological streams of his/her congregation and articulate how beliefs and faith are formed in the congregation.
- 4) Be able to define the relationship between theology and practice and the relationship to a particular life issue.
- 5) Be able to articulate a "theological confession of faith" that expresses the student's basic convictions regarding the Christian message.
